1978- Galvez Mall (EckboKay)

After removing a roadway that divided that campus, the plan substituted bike paths, a promenade, oak trees, and a large lawn. Completed in the 1980s, the Galvez Mall knits the campus together and eliminates conflicts among cars, pedestrians, and cyclists.

1989- Manzanita Master Plan

The Manzanita Park Master Plan has guided the successful development of new student housing, courtyards, a dining hall, and the 1991 Kimball Undergraduate Hall.

DESCRIPTION: 1.5-acre permanent outdoor ecological exhibit supporting the Lawrence Hall's children's science education program. Through dramatic hands-on and interactive displays, the exhibit shows how San Francisco Bay has changed over the past 10,000 years through human impact, hydrologic and geologic forces. It also educates visitors on how they can help protect the Bay and watershed.

DESCRIPTION: 6-acre, 600 unit student housing project design in collaboration Mogavero Notestine and Associates. Located at the northern border of the campus, the project represents the University's first urbanized campus edge housing development. Once a large surface parking lot, the site now houses new buildings, main plaza, entry courtyards, walkways and bike paths connected to the campus circulation system.
