DESCRIPTION: Redesign, City Approvals and Construction Documentation for 3 Major Building Plazas on California Street in Downtown San Francisco.

DESCRIPTION: The 3-block South First Street Demonstration Project focused on recapturing an auto-dominated street experience for the enrichment and use of the public realm all with “non-permanent” components. Project entailed street narrowing, modular sidewalk extensions, in-street planters, sidewalk planters and LED lighting.

DESCRIPTION: Renovation of Bank of America’s Corporate Headquarters and one of the most challenging plaza spaces in San Francisco, according to Herb Caen. Severe wind and solar orientation issues along with an aging landscape were overcome to create a new, green, softened and organized experience. The renovation capitalized on the plaza’s existing framework and original design by landscape architect Larry Halprin.

DESCRIPTION: 800-acre Mixed-Use Master Plan with up to 8.3 million sqft of Industrial, Office and Commercial entitlement. 106-acre, 1.1 million sqft Pacific Commons Retail and Entertainment District completed along with 3 miles of public streets.
