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## Milwaukee Riverwalk Milwaukee, Wisconsin

**CLIENT:** City of Milwaukee  
Mayor John O. Norquist

**ROLE:** Lead Urban Designers

**DESCRIPTION:** Two-mile stretch of the Downtown Milwaukee River and 12 adjacent blocks of river clean-up, riverfront redevelopment and public open-space/access rehabilitation in the heart of downtown. The project received a National Waterfront Award by the Waterfront Center in 1998 and a Catherine Brown Merit Award by the Congress for New Urbanism in 1999.

## Old Mill District Bend, Oregon

**ROLE:** Master Planners and Designers

**DESCRIPTION:** 270-acre downtown site including two miles of the Deschutes River, brown field redevelopment, historic preservation and river clean up from two abandoned saw mills. Successfully completed mixed-use riverfront development, the project received a "Phoenix Award" from the EPA in 1997.

**DESCRIPTION:** 206-acre Waterfront Mixed-Use Development from an existing brownfield abandoned ship-building site. The entire project was completed as planned including a mile of waterfront public access. This project won the Urban Land Institute's national award for excellence in 1991.

## Guadalupe River Park Vision San Jose, California
